

Stewards Elections 2020



UNISON is a member led rather than full time officer led trade union. At the heart of this system is the departmental steward who represents the individual members in the workplace. UNISON is also a democratic union which means your stewards have to be nominated.

The duties of stewards are to distribute UNISON publications to their members, usually once a month, and to act as the first line of response to members' queries: support is always available from Senior Stewards and the UNISON Office at County Hall. They will also operate as Health and Safety representatives. In addition there are regular Branch meetings at which issues are discussed and decisions made. For new stewards there is a five day training course which you should be allowed days off work to attend, and ongoing support from colleagues. If you are interested in becoming a steward you will need to ask someone in your workplace to nominate you. The nomination form should be sent to the Branch Office **by 9 January 2020**. If more than one nomination is received for a particular constituency a secret ballot will be held for the members concerned. UNISON welcomes job sharing, which can be considered when we have more nominations than vacancies.
